## Course Units

### Unit 1: Finding Your Voice

- Master tongue and mouth position for key English sounds (T, D, R, H, TH, V, W).
- Discover the power of listening: record yourself and identify pronunciation habits.
- Build daily routines for clarity and confidence.

**Outcome:** You start hearing yourself like a native and fixing your own mistakes.

### Unit 2: Sounds that Shape Meaning

*Clarity before speed.*

- Learn "lazy sounds" (ʌ & ə) and minimal pairs.
- Understand vowel precision and how accent affects meaning.
- Develop natural rhythm through short dialogues and listening imitation.

**Outcome:** You sound clearer and easier to understand.

### Unit 3: Accent & Intonation

*Speak with melody, not fear.*

- Explore stress, rhythm, and Australian intonation patterns.
- Practise connected speech and word linking.
- Accent awareness: choose your tone and style (Australian, neutral, or international).

**Outcome:** You start sounding confident.

## Unit 4: Speaking in Public

*How to speak in public without fear.*

- Learn techniques to stay calm and sound confident.
- Practice short presentations and storytelling.
- Control your breathing, volume, and body language.

**Outcome:** You feel in control when speaking to a group or audience.

## Unit 5: English for the Workplace

*Confidence at work and in daily communication.*

- Professional pronunciation for meetings, interviews, and calls.
- Practice workplace small talk and polite expressions.
- Record “Job Interview Roleplays” and get pronunciation feedback.

**Outcome:** You speak with authority, clarity, and connection in professional settings.
